

Recommendations for KI researchers regarding FEGA Sweden

Please note: FEGA Sweden cannot currently take on data from KI research projects, as KI is not yet allowing data to be deposited in the repository. These are provisional guidelines until KI permits data to be deposited in FEGA Sweden, and they may change at any time. For any inquiries, please contact the relevant support teams listed below.

If your research at KI involves omics or phenotypic data containing sensitive personal data, please note the following:

- **Depositing data in FEGA Sweden:** If you believe your data is suitable for the repository, you can submit a request via the FEGA Sweden website (<https://fega.nbis.se/submission/submission-request.html>). FEGA Sweden will contact you once KI allows data to be deposited.
- **Persistent identifier for data:** If FEGA Sweden is not yet accepting KI submissions and you need a persistent identifier (e.g., for citation in a manuscript), you should publish the data in the KI Data Repository following KI's guidelines (<https://kib.ki.se/en/publish-analyse/publish-and-share-research-data/doris-publish-and-share-your-research-data>).

- **Data availability statement:** If needed, you may use the following statement in publications:

Information about the datasets included in this study is available at KI Data Repository, DOI {insert DOI}. The data contain sensitive information that cannot be shared openly. Work on depositing the data in FEGA Sweden has been initiated. FEGA Sweden is a national node of the Federated European Genome-phenome Archive (FEGA), which allows data to be shared under controlled access. The datasets in FEGA Sweden are findable through the European Genome-phenome Archive web portal (<https://ega-archive.org>).

- **NAISS SENS projects:** If your NAISS SENS project (formerly SNIC SENS, such as data on Bianca) is ending and you have requested to deposit data in FEGA Sweden, consider the following options:
 - Contact the storage provider to request a project extension.
 - Transfer the data to the KI Data Repository.
